- 24 hr police patrol; less than 5 min response

Annexation Process

- Vote at 100 S. Woodside Parkway on April 14th
 - Town will mail notices in March through early April
 - Absentee ballots 605 West Main St., Lexington, SC; Suite 105 or call 803-785-8361.
 - All voters are required to have a valid photo ID.
- If yes, then Town ordinance process (3 mons.)
- As early as June, enjoy Springdale services!
