Town Council Regular Meeting
November 1, 2011 at 6:00 p.m.

Council Chambers – Springdale Town Hall, 2915 Platt Springs Road

I. Call to Order

Mayor Smith called the meeting to order at 6pm. A quorum was present. Councilmember Hallman provided the invocation.

II. Approval of Minutes

Council, on motion by Mayor Pro Tem Manos, seconded by Councilmember Reeley, voted unanimously to approve the October 4, 2011 regular meeting minutes.

III. Old Business

A. Council, on motion by Councilmember Wilkerson, seconded by Councilmember Hallman, voted unanimously to adopt ordinance O-11-09; an ordinance amending the Town Code of Ordinances, Chapter 5: Buildings and Building Regulation; adding Article XI. Slum and Blight. [SECOND READING]

IV. New Business

A. Judge George Nicholson swore-in Mr. Robert Shaw as patrolman to the Springdale Police Department.

B. Mrs. Cindy Wilkerson, a PE instructor at Springdale Elementary, and Principal Thackston from Springdale Elementary asked Council to consider a partnership with the school to encourage health and fitness in throughout the school and Springdale community. The proposal included the installation of a 300 seat amphitheatre, upgrades to the existing play ground equipment, and educational materials on healthy living. Council, on motion by Mayor Pro Tem Manos, seconded by Councilmember Sox-Peters, voted unanimously to support the partnership and directed the Administrator to pursue a MOU.

C. Council, on motion by Councilmember Reeley, seconded by Mayor Pro Tem Manos, voted unanimously to approve the proposed MOU with the Lexington County Health and Services District.
