Springdale Town Special Called Council Meeting
June 21, 2011

Springdale Town Council met in a Regular Meeting on Tuesday, June 21, 2011 at 6:00 p.m. in the Town Hall Council Chambers. Those present were Mayor Pat Smith, Mayor Pro Tem Gus Manos, Councilmembers Steve Hallman, Jacob Wilkerson, Nancy Sox-Peters, Kevin Reeley, and Town Administrator, Erica Barton. Councilmember Juston Ricard and Town Attorney, Danny Scott were absent due to a prior commitment.

CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Smith called the Council Meeting to order at 6 p.m. Councilmember Hallman provided the invocation.

OLD BUSINESS

- A. Consideration of O-11-04 Budget Ordinance FY12 (p.5). Council, on motion by Mayor Pro-Tem Manos, seconded by Councilmember Reeley voted unanimously to approve the FY12 budget. [Second Reading].
- B. Remembrance Memorial (Law Enforcement and First Responder's). Mayor Smith asked Council if there is any discussion for a contribution towards the First Responder's memorial. No action was taken.

NEW BUSINESS

- A. Consideration of an annexation ordinance O-11-05; James E. Bristow; TMS 5697-01-015 and TMS 5697-01-019. Council asked Administrator Barton to find out if the goats on the property would still be allowed once annexed. Council, on motion by Councilmember Sox-Peters, seconded by Mayor Pro-Tem Manos, voted unanimously to approve the annexation. [FIRST READING]
- B. Consideration of resolution R-11-01: Police Department Mutual Aid Agreements. Chief Johnson explained to Council the need for the governing authority to approve the agreement. Council, on motion by Councilmember Wilkerson, seconded by Councilmember Hallman, voted unanimously to approve the resolution.
- C. Consideration to advertise the Town at Airport High School. Council, on motion by Councilmember Hallman, seconded by Councilmember Reeley, voted unanimously to approve the purchase of a Springdale banner to be displayed at Airport High School for civic pride and tourism.

Council, on motion by Councilmember Reeley, seconded by Mayor Pro Tem Manos, voted unanimously to move into Executive Session.

No action was taken.

Council, on motion by Mayor Pro-Tem Manos, seconded by Councilmember Hallman, voted unanimously to move into regular session.
