MINUTES

Town Council Regular Meeting

November 6, 2012 at 6:00 p.m.

Council Chambers – Springdale Town Hall, 2915 Platt Springs Road

MEMBERS PRESENT: Mayor Pat Smith, Mayor Pro-Tem Manos, Councilmembers Hallman, Reeley, Ricard, and Wilkerson, Town Administrator Erica Barton, and Town Attorney Danny Scott.

MEMBER(S) ABSENT: Councilmember Sox-Peters.

I. Call to Order

Mayor Smith called the meeting to order at 6 p.m. A quorum was present. Councilmember Hallman provided the invocation.

II. Approval of Minutes

Council, on motion by Mayor Pro Tem Manos, seconded by Councilmember Ricard, voted unanimously to approve the October 2, 2012 and October 4, 2012 meeting minutes.

III. Old Business

A. Rich Fletcher from SCANA provided an update on the Platt Springs Road lighting project. He stated that there had been issues coordinating with the SCDOT on payment for the project. The agreement should be in place in December, and construction should be completed by May.

IV. New Business

A. Consideration of O-12-04 and ordinance amending the Business License Ordinance provisions for Insurance Companies. Administrator Barton briefed Council on the issues related to the collection of business license fees for insurance companies caused by changes in legislation. Council on motion by Councilmember Wilkerson, seconded by Councilmember Reeley, voted unanimously to adopt O-12-04 an ordinance amending the Business License Ordinance provisions for insurance companies.

B. Consideration of an agreement with the Municipal Association For Collection Of All Business License Taxes From Insurance Companies and Administration as Municipal Agent of Municipal Brokers Premium Tax. Council on motion by Councilmember Reeley, seconded by Mayor Pro Tem Manos, voted unanimously to adopt the agreement with the Municipal Association For Collection Of All Business License Taxes From Insurance Companies and Administration as Municipal Agent of Municipal Brokers Premium Tax.

V. Reports

A. The Administrator briefed Council on proposed changes to the Business License Ordinance that were being considered, and on the “No Thru Trucks” signs being considered for W. Fairhill Road and Tarrytown Lane. Mr. John McGuinness, a resident of W. Fairhill, spoke to Council indicating the necessity for the sign. The Administrator then referred Council to her monthly report.

B. Chief Cornett reviewed his monthly report and statistics with Council. The Chief thanked Council for all of their support at National Night Out. Mayor Smith noted that the October date seemed to be more successful than the usual August National Night Out.
