Town Council Regular Meeting

March 12, 2013 at 6:00 p.m.

Council Chambers – Springdale Town Hall, 2915 Platt Springs Road

The media and public were duly notified of the date, time, and place of this meeting.

**I. Call to Order**

Mayor Smith called the meeting to order at 6 p.m. A quorum was present. Councilmember Hallman provided the invocation.

**II. Approval of Minutes**

Council, on motion by Mayor Pro Tem Manos, seconded by Councilmember Wilkerson, voted unanimously to approve the February 5, 2013 meeting minutes.

P-13-02: Mayors for Meals. Council, on motion by Councilmember Hallman, seconded by Councilmember Manos, voted unanimously to approve the proclamation.

**IV. Old Business**

A. Consideration of resolution R-13-03; requesting DOT to install No Thru Trucks Signs on Tarrytown Lane and West Fairhill Drive. Council, on motion by Councilmember Wilkerson, seconded by Mayor Pro Tem Manos, voted unanimously to approve resolution R-13-03; requesting DOT to install No Thru Trucks signs on Tarrytown Lane and West Fairhill Drive.

B. Update on Cindy's Place BBQ Fundraiser on March 22, 2013. Taylor Summers updated Council on the status of the BBQ Fundraiser to benefit Cindy's Place.
