Town Council Regular Meeting

June 4, 2013 at 6:00 p.m.

Council Chambers – Springdale Town Hall, 2915 Platt Springs Road

The media and public were duly notified of the date, time, and place of this meeting.

MEMBERS PRESENT: Mayor Pat Smith, Mayor Pro-Tem Manos, Councilmembers Reeley, Ricard, Sox-Peters and Wilkerson, Town Administrator Erica Barton, and Town Attorney Danny Scott.

MEMBER(S) ABSENT: Councilmember Hallman.

I. Call to Order

Mayor Smith called the meeting to order at 6 p.m. A quorum was present. Councilmember Ricard provided the invocation.

II. Approval of Minutes

Council, on motion by Mayor Pro Tem Manos, seconded by Councilmember Reeley, voted unanimously to approve the May 7, 2013 meeting minutes.

III. Proclamations and Resolutions

VII. Appearance by citizens

Mrs. Deltrease Hart-Anderson inquired about insurance coverage of town vehicles while loaned to neighboring municipalities. Mr. Boyes stated that the town was covered under the Municipal Association's plan. She inquired about Community Development Block Grant eligibility for the town's businesses. Mayor Smith stated that the town has traditionally not qualified due to demographic requirements for eligibility.
