Town Council Regular Meeting

August 6, 2013 at 6:00 p.m.

Council Chambers – Springdale Town Hall, 2915 Platt Springs Road

The media and public were duly notified of the date, time, and place of this meeting.

MEMBERS PRESENT: Mayor Pat Smith, Mayor Pro-Tem Manos, Councilmembers Hallman, Reeley, Ricard, and Wilkerson, and Town Administrator Erica Barton.

MEMBER(S) ABSENT: Councilmember Sox-Peters and Town Attorney Danny Scott.

**I. Call to Order**

Mayor Smith called the meeting to order at 6 p.m. A quorum was present. Councilmember Hallman provided the invocation.

**II. Approval of Minutes**

A. Council, on motion by Mayor Pro Tem Manos, seconded by Councilmember Reeley, voted unanimously to approve the June 4, 2013 and June 25, 2013 meeting minutes.

**III. Proclamations and Resolutions**

A. Resolution R-13-06: A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT FOR THE TOWN OF SPRINGDALE AND THE SC DEPARTMENT OF JUVENILE JUSTICE FOR THE DETENTION OF JUVENILES. Council, on motion by Councilmember Wilkerson, seconded by Councilmember Hallman, voted unanimously to approve R-13-06: a resolution to approve an agreement between the Town of Springdale and the SC Department of juvenile justice for the detention of juveniles.

B. Resolution R-13-07: A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF A SAFE WORK ENVIRONMENT. Council, on motion by Mayor Pro Tem Manos, seconded by Councilmember Ricard, voted unanimously to approve R-13-07: a resolution to support a safe work environment.

C. Resolution R-13-08: A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE BB&T FINANCING FOR A POLICE VEHICLE. Council, on motion by Councilmember Wilkerson, seconded by Mayor Pro Tem Manos, voted unanimously to approve R-13-08: a resolution for financing of a police vehicle by BB&T.

B. Recommendation from Auditor Selection Committee for FY13 Town Audit. Council, on motion by Councilmember Hallman, seconded by Councilmember Ricard, voted to select the Hobbs Group to conduct the fiscal year 2013 audit. Mayor Pro Tem Manos abstained from the vote.

A. Administrator Barton referred Council to her monthly report. She briefed Council on the progress of the lighting initiative along Platt Springs Road and Airport Boulevard.

B. The Public Works Director's report was received as information by Council. Mayor Smith commended the efforts of the town employees during the aftermath of the recent storm.

C. Chief Cornett reviewed his monthly report and statistics with Council. The Chief informed Council that he completed the DARE instructor training along with Officer McWilliams, and they would begin instructing the students of Springdale Elementary in the fall.
