**SPRINGDALE**

Springdale Town Regular Council Meeting  
June 7, 2011

Springdale Town Council met in a Regular Meeting on Tuesday, June 7, 2011 at 6:00 p.m. in the Town Hall Council Chambers. Those present were Mayor Pat Smith, Mayor Pro Tem Gus Manos, Councilmembers Steve Hallman, Jacob Wilkerson, Nancy Sox-Peters, Kevin Reeley, Town Attorney, Danny Scott and Town Administrator, Erica Barton. Councilmember Juston Ricard was absent due to a prior commitment.

**CALL TO ORDER**

Mayor Smith called the Council Meeting to order at 6 p.m. Councilmember Hallman provided the invocation. Mayor Smith stated that the Chief's Police Report will be moved to item 3 under New Business.

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

Council, on motion by Mayor Pro-Tem Manos, seconded by Councilmember Hallman, voted unanimously to approve the minutes from the May regular meeting.

**OLD BUSINESS**

- A. Consideration of O-11-03 Zoning Ordinance Text Amendment Section 1.9 Annexed Property; Amending Subsection 1.9.1 and 1.9.2; Adding subsection 1.9.3. (p. 3). Council, on motion by Councilmember Wilkerson, seconded by Councilmember Sox-Peters, voted unanimously to approve the amendment [SECOND READING].

**NEW BUSINESS**

- A. Consideration of O-11-04 Budget Ordinance FY12 (p.5). Administrator Barton presented a budget overview to Council. Mayor Pro-Tem Manos asked the Administrator to be mindful of cash flow and consider prioritizing major purchases. Council, on motion by Mayor Pro-Tem Manos, seconded by Councilmember Wilkerson voted unanimously to approve the FY12 budget. [First Reading].
- B. Remembrance Memorial (Law Enforcement and First Responder's). Chief Johnson explained that the law enforcement memorial is primarily a Lexington community memorial and the First Responder's is a national memorial. Council, on motion by Mayor Pro-Tem Manos, seconded by Councilmember Wilkerson, voted unanimously to donate \$2500 to the Lexington Law Enforcement memorial.
- C. Chief of Police's Report. Chief provided Council with an overview of the monthly stats.

**ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION**

- A. Yard Trash. Administrator Barton asked Council to consider amending the yard trash ordinance to provide the Town more flexibility. Council asked that the amendments be considerate to seniors and that in the meantime, the Town should work towards collecting as much yard trash as is reasonable.
- B. Dog Ordinance. Mayor Pro-Tem Manos stated that he gets complaints about barking dogs and asks Council to consider revisiting the ordinance.
