MINUTES

Town Council Regular Meeting

October 2, 2012 at 6:00 p.m.

Council Chambers – Springdale Town Hall, 2915 Platt Springs Road

MEMBERS PRESENT: Mayor Pat Smith, Mayor Pro-Tem Manos, Councilmember Sox-Peters, Reeley, Ricard, and Wilkerson, Town Administrator Erica Barton, and Town Attorney Danny Scott.

MEMBER(S) ABSENT: Councilmember Hallman.

I. Call to Order

Mayor Smith called the meeting to order at 6 p.m. A quorum was present. Councilmember Ricard provided the invocation.

II. Approval of Minutes

Council, on motion by Mayor Pro Tem Manos, seconded by Councilmember Reeley, voted unanimously to approve the September 4, 2012 meeting minutes.

III. Officer Swear-In

Mayor Smith turned the floor over to Judge Nicholson for the swearing-in of Officer Potts to the position of Corporal and Evan McWilliams to the position of Patrolman.

IV. Reports

A. Chief Cornett reviewed his monthly report with Council. He invited everyone to come out to the National Night Out festivities taking place in the park. The Chief updated Council on the neighborhood watch program. He stated that they had sent out 275 letters to community members about the program and that they would be speaking at upcoming neighborhood meetings.

B. The Administrator asked the new Public Works Director Josh Ancik to introduce himself. Mr. Ancik thanked Council for the opportunity and introduced his new team member Trevor Sharpe and updated Council on the new grapple truck. Next, the Administrator referred Council to her monthly report.

V. Old Business

A. Donation request for Aviation Foundation. Mayor Smith asked Harold Jones to provide a little information about the project. Mr. Jones informed Council that this was an attempt to build a memorial to all the airmen who had trained at the Columbia Air Base during World War II. Councilmember Wilkerson asked where the monument would go. Mr. Jones provided the location. Council, on motion by Mayor Pro Tem Manos, seconded by Councilmember Peters voted unanimously to donate \$500 to the project.

VI. New Business

A. Consideration of the MOA Brownfields Coalition Grant FY14. Administrator Barton informed Council that the Town was going to pursue grant funds from the EPA as a part of the Congaree Coalition with neighboring municipalities. Council, on motion by Councilmember Wilkerson, seconded by Councilmember Reeley, voted unanimously to approve the MOA.

B. Consideration of Accommodation Tax Grant request. Mr. John Banks of the West Metro Chamber of Commerce presented his organization's request for A-Tax grant funds. He thanked the Town for their continued support of Chamber and the visitor's center, both financially and otherwise. Council, on motion by Councilmember Wilkerson, seconded by Mayor Pro Tem Manos voted unanimously to award \$2500 in A-Tax funds to the West Metro Chamber of Commerce.

VII. Appearance by citizens

There were no questions from the citizens.

VIII. Adjournment

Council, on motion by Councilmember Reeley, seconded by Mayor Pro Tem Manos, voted unanimously to adjourn at 6:30 p.m.
