MINUTES

Town Council Regular Meeting

November 12, 2013 at 6:00 p.m.

Council Chambers – Springdale Town Hall, 2915 Platt Springs Road

The media and public were duly notified of the date, time, and place of this meeting.

MEMBERS PRESENT: Mayor Pat Smith, Mayor Pro-Tem Manos, Councilmembers Hallman, Reeley, Ricard, and Sox-Peters, Town Administrator Erica Barton, and Town Attorney Danny Scott.

MEMBER(S) ABSENT: Councilmember Wilkerson.

I. Call to Order

Mayor Smith called the meeting to order at 6 p.m. A quorum was present. Councilmember Hallman provided the invocation.

II. Approval of Minutes

A. Council, on motion by Mayor Pro Tem Manos, seconded by Councilmember Reeley, voted unanimously to approve the October 1, 2013 meeting minutes.

III. New Business

A. Council election of Mayor Pro Tempore. Council, based on a nomination by Councilmember Sox-Peters, seconded by Councilmember Reeley, voted 5 to 0 to elect Gus Manos as Mayor Pro Tempore for the Springdale Town Council. Mr. Manos abstained from the vote.

IV. Reports

A. Administrator Barton referred Council to her monthly report. She highlighted the ordinance summary that was included in Council's packet. Administrator Barton noted that the preliminary independent audit was completed and should be presented in January.

Mayor Pro Tem Manos asked the Administrator to look into doing something about solicitation in the town.

Mayor Smith notified the members of Council that the town has received the Distinguished Budget Presentation Award from the Government Finance Officers Association for the FY14 budget document.

B. The Public Works Director's report was received as information by Council.

C. Chief Cornett reviewed his monthly report and statistics with Council. Mayor Pro Tem Manos asked about the situation with the hotels on Airport Boulevard. Chief Cornett stated that he has been in contact with the hotels and is taking steps to ensure that the town is holding them accountable. Administrator

Barton updated Council on the steps that Mr. Sinha is taking with the renovations to his hotel property. She encouraged Council to stop by to see the progress he is making.

V. Adjournment

Council, on motion by Mayor Pro Tem Manos, seconded by Councilmember Reeley, voted unanimously to adjourn at 6:25 p.m.
