MINUTES

Town Council Regular Meeting
November 1, 2016 at 6:00 p.m.

Council Chambers – Springdale Town Hall, 2915 Platt Springs Road

The media and public were duly notified of the date, time, and place of this meeting.

MEMBERS PRESENT: Mayor Michael Bishop, Mayor Pro Tem Ricard, Councilmembers Hallman, Wilkerson, Peters, Reeley, and Fecas, Town Administrator Jeff Stilwell, and Town Attorney Danny Scott.

MEMBERS ABSENT: None.

I. Call to Order

Mayor Bishop called the meeting to order at 6 P.M. A quorum was present. Mayor Pro Tem Ricard provided the invocation. Life Scout Hunter Purvis of Troop 331 led the Pledge of Allegiance.

II. Consent Agenda

A. Approval of Agenda. Council approved the agenda without objection.

B. Approval of Minutes. Council adopted the minutes from the October 4, 2016 Regular Meeting and the minutes from the October 17, 2016 Work Session without objection.

III. Presentations

A. Platt Springs Road United Methodist Church Joy Club. Chief Cornett recognized the work done by the Joy Club's donation of a canine ballistics vest to the Springdale Police Department's own canine officer, Bruce. The Joy Club spoke to the meeting and thanked the Police Department for all its hard work.

IV. Appointments

A. Appoint Amanda Jones as the Town Clerk of Court. Administrator Stilwell explained that this was the formal appointment and that Ms. Jones would be present for recognition at the next Council meeting. The Council, on motion of Councilmember Fecas, seconded by Councilmember Wilkerson, voted unanimously to appoint Amanda Jones as the Town Clerk of Court.

V. Old Business

A. Consideration of Change of Developer for Planned Development District located between Ermine Road and Watling Road. Administrator Stilwell explained that the Town had not heard back from the legal team for the purchaser.

VI. New Business

A. Consideration of Ordinance O-16-08: An Ordinance of the Town of Springdale, South Carolina approving mutual aid agreements with multiple jurisdictions within the State of South Carolina. Chief Cornett explained that this blanket ordinance would enable him to sign each mutual aid agreement as it comes in rather than Council having to adopt each agreement separately. Council, on motion of Councilmember Peters, seconded by Councilmember Reeley, voted unanimously to approve Ordinance O-16-08 approving the mutual aid agreements with multiple jurisdictions.

VII. Reports

A. Town Council Reports. Mayor Bishop discussed his school trip with Transform SC and his attendance of the Gervais Street Bridge Dinner. Mayor Bishop discussed an upcoming SCDOT meeting in November concerning the dams in Springdale and the affected roads.

B. Administrative Report. Administrator Stilwell also discussed the SCDOT meeting as well as the final food truck rodeo of the year. He also discussed setting dates for the Town tree lighting and the Town Christmas party for December 5th and 8th respectively. Lastly, Administrator Stilwell updated council on the progress of Southern Resource Advisors in the business license audit and meetings he had attended. Council discussed the sale of the Town's Christmas lights to the Town of Ninety-Six.

C. Public Works Director's Report. Public Works Director Ancik's report was received as information by Council. Mayor Bishop promoted the available extra dumpsters for trash, recycling, and yard trash.

D. Chief's Report. Chief Cornett reviewed his monthly report and statistics with the Council. Council congratulated Chief for his "40 Under 40" award and Administrator Stilwell praised Officer's Gantt and Goodwin.

VIII. Appearance by Citizens

Life Scout Hunter Purvis discussed his Eagle Scout project with the Council and his upcoming fundraiser for the project.

IX. Adjournment

Council, on motion of Councilmember Fecas, seconded by Councilmember Reeley, voted unanimously to adjourn the meeting at 6:30 P.M.
