MINUTES

Town Council Regular Meeting
October 3, 2017 at 6:00 p.m.

Council Chambers – Springdale Town Hall, 2915 Platt Springs Road

The media and public were duly notified of the date, time, and place of this meeting.

MEMBERS PRESENT: Mayor Michael Bishop, Councilmembers Reeley, Peters, Hallman, Wilkerson, and Fecas, , and Interim Administrator Ashley Watkins.

MEMBERS ABSENT: Mayor Pro Tem Ricard, Town Attorney Danny Scott

I. Call to Order

Mayor Bishop called the meeting to order at 6 P.M. A quorum was present. Councilmember Halman provided the invocation. Mayor Bishop led the Pledge of Allegiance. Mayor Pro Tem Ricard was noted as absent due to his volunteering with Springdale Police Department’s National Night Out in the park.

II. Consent Agenda

- A. Approval of Agenda. Council adopted the agenda for the meeting without objection.
- B. Approval of Minutes. Council adopted the minutes from the September 5, 2017 Regular Meeting, the September 15, 2017 Special Meeting, the September 18, 2017 Work Session, and the September 20, 2017 Special Meeting without objection.

III. Old Business

- A. Ordinance O-17-08: An ordinance providing for the enforcement of park rules. Mayor Bishop informed Council that, without this ordinance, the Police Department lacks the authority to enforce park rules. Council, on motion of Councilmember Wilkerson, seconded by Councilmember Reeley, voted unanimously to give second reading to Ordinance O-17-08.
- B. Ordinance O-17-09: An ordinance adopting the Lexington County Animal Control Ordinance by reference. Mayor Bishop explained that the Town needed to adopt this ordinance to be in compliance with Lexington County Animal Control. Council discussed the County’s new rules for handling cats and the cost it puts on the citizens. Council, on motion of Councilmember Fecas, seconded by Councilmember Hallman, voted unanimously to give second reading to Ordinance O-17-09.

- A. Town Council Reports. Council had no new information to report this month.
- B. Chief’s Report. Chief Cornett’s monthly report was received as information by Council.

C. Public Works Director's Report. Public Works Director Ancik's report was received as information by Council.

D. Administrative Report. Mayor Bishop asked Interim Administrator Watkins for an update on the flow beds bids for the medians and she responded that she has not received new information. Council discussed the additions to medians including the flowers and irrigation.
