MINUTES

Town Council Special Meeting

June 22, 2017 at 6:00 p.m.

Council Chambers – Springdale Town Hall, 2915 Platt Springs Road

The media and public were duly notified of the date, time, and place of this meeting.

MEMBERS PRESENT: Mayor Pro Tem Ricard, Councilmembers Reeley, Peters, Wilkerson, and Fecas, and Town Administrator Jeff Stilwell.

MEMBERS ABSENT: Mayor Michael Bishop, Councilmember Hallman, and Town Attorney Danny Scott.

I. Call to Order

Mayor Pro Tem Ricard called the meeting to order at 6 P.M. A quorum was present. Mayor Pro Tem Ricard provided the invocation and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

II. Consent Agenda

A. Approval of Agenda. Council approved the agenda without objection.

III. Old Business

A. Consideration of Ordinance O-17-04 Regarding : AMENDING THE TOWN OF SPRINGDALE ZONING ORDINANCE REGULATIONS, SECTION 4.4 “SIGNS” TO PERMIT AND REGULATE THE USE OF LED SIGNS WITHIN TOWN LIMITS, MODIFYING SUBSECTION 4.4.8 “PROHIBITED SIGNS”. Councilmember Reeley expressed concerns that not enough research had been done on LED signs in neighboring municipalities. Council discussed the businesses that had requested the ordinance and the regulations. Councilmember Reeley shared his concerns about what could result from the ordinance. Council, on motion of Councilmember Fecas, seconded by Councilmember Wilkerson, voted to give second reading to Ordinance O-17-04. Mayor Pro Tem Ricard, and Councilmembers Fecas, Wilkerson, and Peters in favor and Councilmember Reeley opposed.

B. Consideration of Ordinance O-17-05 Regarding : AMENDING THE TOWN OF SPRINGDALE ZONING ORDINANCE MAP FOR THE PROPERTY AT 322 JOHN WAYNE DRIVE, TAX MAP #005615-01-043, FROM PDD to P1 – PUBLIC. Council discussed the construction at the school and asked for the school district to keep them informed of the construction progress. Council, on motion of Councilmember Peters, seconded by Councilmember Fecas, voted unanimously to give second reading to Ordinance O-17-05.

C. Consideration of Ordinance O-17-06: TO PROVIDE FOR THE ADOPTION OF A TOWN OPERATING BUDGET, ITS EXECUTION AND EFFECT, FOR THE FISCAL PERIOD JULY 1, 2017 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2018. Mayor Pro Tem Ricard opened the public hearing at 6:07 P.M. No members of the public offered comment on the budget. Mayor Pro Tem Ricard closed the public hearing

at 6:08 P.M. Council, on motion of Councilmember Wilkerson, seconded by Councilmember Peters, voted unanimously to give second reading to Ordinance O-17-06.

IV. New Business

A. Consideration of Ordinance O-17-07 Regarding: AMENDING THE TOWN OF SPRINGDALE ORDINANCE REGULATIONS, ADDING ARTICLE 5 “FREEDOM OF INFORMATION” AND SUBSEQUENT SECTIONS TO COMPLY WITH CHANGES IN STATE FOIA STATUTES. Council, on motion of Councilmember Fecas, seconded by Councilmember Wilkerson, voted unanimously to give first reading to Ordinance O-17-07.
