SPRINGDALE PUBLIC WORKS PROHIBITED MATERIALS



USED AUTO OR COOKING OILS

Must be disposed of properly in the designated container at the Oil/fuel Collection area at your nearest Collection and Recycle Center.

TIRES

Residents may drop off up to four tires (with rims) from their primary residence at select Recycling and Collection Centers.



BATTERIES



Rechargeable or lithium-ion batteries are accepted at the Edmund Landfill. Lead-acid batteries can be collected at any Collection and Recycling Center. Nonrechargeable batteries may be disposed of with household garbage

CHEMICALS

Including lawn, pool, cleaning chemicals and fertilizers. Residents may drop off acceptable hazardous waste items for disposal at Household Hazardous Waste Dropoff Opportunities





ELECTRONICS

Computers, computer monitors, printers, televisions, etc. Must be recycled at the Edmund Landfill.

APPLIANCES

Refrigerators, ranges, water heaters, freezers, etc. Recycle at your nearest Collection and Recycling Center or the Edmund Landfill





LOOSE LEAVES AND SAND/DIRT

Leaves must be bagged or in a container. Sand, soil, or dirt will not be picked up.

CONSTRUCTION AND LAND CLEARING DEBRIS

Must be taken to the Edmund Landfill to be recycled.





EQUIPMENT MOTORS OR SCRAP METAL

Empty all fluids and recycle at any Collection & Recycling Centers

PROPANE AND GAS TANKS

Must be taken to the Edmund Landfill to be recycled.
